The conference will be held over one day and will be divided into parallel thematic sessions. You are invited to present papers on the following topics:

- Refugees and reception measures;
- Immigration policies and territories: inclusion and exclusion;
- Work: insertion, promotion, exploitation;
- Gender and Migration;
- Civil society and solidarity with migrants and refugees;
- Xenophobia and racism;
- Migrants' new generations: school, work, social participation;
- Transnational and reunited families;
- Migrations, media and political communication;
- Immigration and religious pluralism;
- Migrant networks, associations and participation;
- Intercultural mediation and social work.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Interested contributors are invited to submit an abstract to: medi@csmedi.com by 15 January 2010.

The abstract must include:

- a. Author (surname, name and year of birth);
- b. Affiliation;
- c. Title of the paper with an indication of the topic for which one is applying;
- d. Summary of the paper (no more than 600 words, including references);
- e. Author's email address

Proposals can be presented and discussed in the following languages: Italian, English, French and Spanish

Notifications of acceptance status will be sent by February 4th, 2020. If an abstract has been accepted, authors should submit a final paper by February 21^h. A final paper refers to an organic document, structured in paragraphs, accompanied by a relevant bibliography, written in Italian, English, French or Spanish. The length must be between 6,000 and 8,000 words

If the paper is not sent in the full version, presentation during the conference will not be allowed.

The registration fee for the presentation will be 120 €, that includes the subscription to *Mondi Migranti* for 2019.

After making a first selection within the thematic sections, the best paper conference, presented by an author of no more than 40, will be awarded with the "Mondi Migranti Young Award" and proposed for publication in the *Journal* – subjected to standard revision – in the year 2021. The author will be also invited to give a lecture at the Summer School of Sociology of Migration 2020 which will be held in Genoa from 6 to 10 July.
